RESOLUTION NO. 5, 2016**

WHEREAS the Town of Upton, Wyoming believes it is important to establish a date upon which its residents may recognize and celebrate the importance of trees in Upton, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS the Town of Upton, Wyoming urges its residents to plant trees annually and to care for the trees so that all persons may enjoy the beauty of trees in Upton, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS the Town of Upton, Wyoming recognizes that trees provide a living legacy for future generations of its residents to use and enjoy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Governing Body of the Town of Upton, Wyoming, that:

June 5, 2016, and annually thereafter, is hereby proclaimed as Arbor Day in the Town of Upton, Wyoming, to be celebrated and observed as may be appropriate to honor the importance of trees in our daily lives and to promote the planting and care of trees in Upton, Wyoming.
