## RESOLUTION NO. 11, 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF UPTON, WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING ADOPTING UTILITY RATE AMOUNT INCREASES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Upton, Weston County, Wyoming has found it necessary to update rates, deposits and fees associated with enterprise funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of Upton, Weston County, Wyoming imposes fees to recoup the costs of all services resulting from all enterprise funds expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Upton, Weston County, Wyoming is required to balance the budget and all enterprise funds must be self sustaining; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of Upton, Weston County, Wyoming that rate increases in the following particulars will become effective August 1, 2020:

- 1. The minimum charge for water service of \$16.50 shall be deemed a meter access fee and no longer include the first 1,000 gallons of water usage for all user types other than those noted in #2.
- 2. The minimum charge for water service of \$33.00 shall be deemed a meter access fee and no longer include the first 1,000 gallons of water usage for out-of-city-limits users.
- 3. The rate for each 1,000 gallons of water used shall increase approximately 10% or \$0.35 from \$3.30 to \$3.65 per thousand for all user types other than those noted in #4.
- 4. The rate for each 1,000 gallons of water used shall increase approximately 10% or \$0.70 from \$6.60 to \$7.30 for out-of-city-limits users.
