The funds will be used to cure end of the year expenditures for general government salaries in the amount of \$3,562.99, loss to cure market value of Certificates of Deposit in the amount of \$17,451.90, court salaries in the amount of \$78.01, cemetery salaries in the amount of \$240.05, that are above and beyond anticipated expenditures; and ARPA expenditures in the amount of \$21,300.64.
 - b. Increase the Sanitation Fund Budget by \$6,330.00 by budgeting \$6,330.00 from sanitation/landfill fund reserves. The funds will be used to cure end of year expenditures for contract garbage hauling in the amount of \$6,330.00 due to additional carboard trailer tips.
