RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT RESOLUTION NO. 23, 2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT PROGRAM ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE TOWN OF UPTON

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for the Town of Upton has identified the need for access to outdoor recreational activities and has established a project called Cedar Pines Golf Course Pumphouse Replacement (Phase I); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Upton recognizes this project will create public benefits by providing more opportunities to enjoy outdoor recreation activities; and

WHEREAS, the LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND (LWCF) program, administered by the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources, is a federal grant program designed to assist in development and/or acquisition of public outdoor recreation lands, and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Upton will encumber 100% of the grant request funding \$58,000.00 for Phase I, which includes both federal funds requested, cash match and in-kind match, for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, all promised cash match amounts have been deposited with the Town of Upton into an interest-bearing account with Wyoming Class and all funds will be made available for this purpose and all in-kind match materials and/or equipment have been delivered to the Town, and all in-kind match labor has been arranged to be provided per signed agreement with the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Upton designates that Cedar Pines Golf Course will only be used for outdoor recreation in perpetuity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF UPTON, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and the City Clerk/Treasurer to attest, a grant application to the Land and Water Conservation Fund administered by the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources in the amount of up to \$29,000.00 in federal funds for the Cedar Pines Golf Course Pumphouse Replacement (Phase I) project.
