**RESOLUTION FOR VACATION OF A PORTION OF FOURTH STREET IN
BLOCK 48 OF THE SAWMILL ADDITION, TOWN OF UPTON, WESTON
COUNTY, WYOMING**

WHEREAS, Town of Upton wishes to vacate a portion of Fourth Street in Block 48 of the Sawmill Addition, Upton, Weston County, Wyoming, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Upton believes it may be in the best interest of the Town and its residents to vacate this portion of the street.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE TOWN OF UPTON, WYOMING:**

1. The Town of Upton, Wyoming, shall publish notice to vacate for three consecutive weeks in the Weston County Gazette, Upton, Wyoming. This notice shall be substantially as follows:

To All It May Concern: A petition has been filed with the Upton Town Council requesting that it vacate a portion of a public street in the Town of Upton, Wyoming, as follows:

a) A portion of Fourth Street in Block 48, Sawmill Addition, Upton, Weston County, Wyoming

All objections to the vacation or claims for damages by reason of such vacation must be filed in writing with the Upton Town Clerk, P.O. Box 203, Upton, Wyoming, 82730, or at the Upton Town Hall, before noon on the 11th day of August, 2026. If not timely filed, this may be vacated without reference to such objections or claims for damages. The Town Council will consider this matter at its meeting on August 11, 2026, at 7:20 P.M.

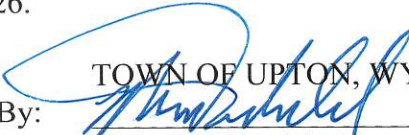

2. The Upton Town Council shall consider the petition to vacate at its regular meeting on August 11, 2026, at 7:20 P.M. Objections and claims for damages not timely filed in writing with the Town Clerk will be disregarded and not considered, and shall be deemed to have been waived and barred.

3. If the Upton Town Council proceeds with the vacation, it shall do so by ordinance. Upon final passage, the Town Clerk shall file a certified copy of the ordinance in the office of the County Clerk of Weston County.
